


INTENTIONS TO PLANT SUMMER CROPS / VOORNEME OM SOMERGEWASSE TE PLANT (2012)

25 October / Oktober 2011

Based on inputs received from a sample of producers and representatives of Provincial Departments of Agriculture, the expected area planted to maize for 2012 is estimated at 2,602 million ha, which is 9,7% or 229 900 ha more than the 2,372 million ha planted last season.

The figures show that producers intend to plant 1,564 million ha to white maize, which is 145 900 ha (10,3%) more than in the previous season. In the case of yellow maize, the expected plantings is 1,038 million ha, which is 84 000 ha (8,8%) more than in the previous season.

These figures give an indication of the intentions of commercial farmers to plant summer crops as at the middle of October 2011. Farmers indicated that the main reason for the increase in the intended area to be planted to maize is favourable prices compared with the same period a year ago. However, late or excessive rainfall can still influence farmers' decisions to plant other summer grain crops.

In the case of **sunflower seed**, the expected area planted is estimated at 555 000 ha, which is 13,6 % or 87 700 ha less than the 642 700 ha planted last season. The intended plantings of **soya-beans** shows an increase of 10,0 % compared to the previous season – from 418 000 ha to 460 000 ha.

The expected plantings of **groundnuts** increased by 5,2% compared to the previous season - from 55 150 ha to 58 000 ha.

The intended plantings of **sorghum** and **dry beans** is expected to decrease by 31,8% and 16,5%, respectively as compared to the previous season.

At the forthcoming meeting of the Crop Estimates Liaison Committee to be held on 1 December 2011, the size of the summer grain crops for 2011 will be finalised.

Gebaseer op insette ontvang vanaf 'n steekproef van produsente en verteenwoordigers van Provinsiale Departemente van Landbou, word die verwagte oppervlakte met mielies beplant vir 2012 beraam op 2,602 miljoen ha, wat 9,7% of 229 900 ha meer is as die 2,372 miljoen ha aangeplant verlede seisoen.

Die syfers toon dat produsente van voorneme is om 1,564 miljoen ha witmielies aan te plant, wat 145 900 ha (10,3%) meer is as in die vorige seisoen. In die geval met geelmielies is die verwagte aanplantings 1,038 miljoen ha, wat 84 000 ha (8,8%) meer is as in die vorige seisoen.

Hierdie syfers gee 'n aanduiding van kommersiële boere se voornemens om somergewasse te plant soos teen middel Oktober 2011. Boere het aangedui dat die toename in die beplande oppervlakte onder mielies hoofsaaklik toegeskryf kan word aan gunstiger pryse in vergelyking met dieselfde periode 'n jaar gelede. Bo en behalwe dié faktor, kan laat of bo-gemiddelde reënval steeds boere se besluite beïnvloed om ander somergraangewasse aan te plant.

In die geval van **sonneblomsaad** word die verwagte aanplantings beraam op 555 000 ha, wat 13,6 % of 87 700 ha minder is as die 642 700 ha aangeplant verlede seisoen. Die voorgename **sojaboon-aanplantings** toon 'n toename van 10,0 % in vergelyking met die vorige seisoen - vanaf 418 000 ha tot 460 000 ha.

Die verwagte aanplantings van **grondbone** neem toe met 5,2% in vergelyking met die vorige seisoen – van 55 150 ha tot 58 000 ha.

Die voorgename aanplantings van **sorghum** en **droëbone** neem af met onderskeidelik 31,8% en 16,5%, in vergelyking met die vorige seisoen.

Tydens die eerskomende vergadering van die Oesskattingskakeelkomitee wat geskeduleer is vir 1 Desember 2011, sal die grootte van die somergewas-oeste vir 2011 gefinaliseer word.




Winter cereal crops - 2011 production season

Wheat: The expected production of wheat is 1,842 mill. tons, which is 3,21% less than the previous forecast of 1,903 mill. tons, whilst the expected yield is 3,05 t/ha.

The expected production in the Western Cape is 636 000 tons, which is 26 500 tons less than the previous forecast. The expected production in the Free State is 551 250 tons, which is 33 750 tons lower than the previous forecast, and in the Northern Cape, the expected production is 273 000 tons, which is the same than the previous forecast. The decrease in the expected production of wheat can mainly be attributed to unfavourable weather conditions in some provinces.

The area estimate for wheat remained unchanged at 604 700 ha.

Other crops: The production forecast for **malting barley** is 251 960 tons, which is 6,06% or 14 400 tons more than the previous forecast of 237 560 tons. The area planted is estimated at 80 150 ha, while the expected yield is 3,14 t/ha.

The expected **canola** crop remained unchanged at 57 340 tons. The area estimate for canola is 43 510 ha, with an expected yield of 1,32 t/ha.

Please note that the fourth production forecast for winter cereals for 2011 will be released on 24 November 2011.

Wintergewasse - 2011 produksie-seisoen

Koring: Die verwagte produksie vir koring is 1,842 milj. ton, 3,21% minder as die vorige skatting van 1,903 milj. ton, terwyl die verwagte opbrengs 3,05 t/ha is.

Die verwagte produksie in die Wes-Kaap is 636 000 ton, wat 26 500 ton minder is as die vorige skatting. Die verwagte produksie in die Vrystaat is 551 250 ton, wat 33 750 ton laer is as die vorige skatting, en in die Noord-Kaap is die verwagte produksie 273 000 ton, wat dieselfde is as die vorige skatting. Die afname in die verwagte produksie van koring kan hoofsaaklik toegeskryf word aan ongunstige weerstoestande in sommige provinsies.

Die oppervlakteskatting vir koring is onveranderd gelaat op 604 700 ha.

Ander gewasse: Die produksieskatting vir **moutgars** is 251 960 ton, wat 6,06% of 14 400 ton meer is as die vorige skatting van 237 560 ton. Die oppervlakte beplant is beraam op 80 150 ha, terwyl die verwagte opbrengs 3,14 t/ha beloop.

Die verwagte **kanola**-oes is onveranderd gelaat op 57 340 ton. Die oppervlakteskatting vir kanola is 43 510 ha, met 'n verwagte opbrengs van 1,32 t/ha.
