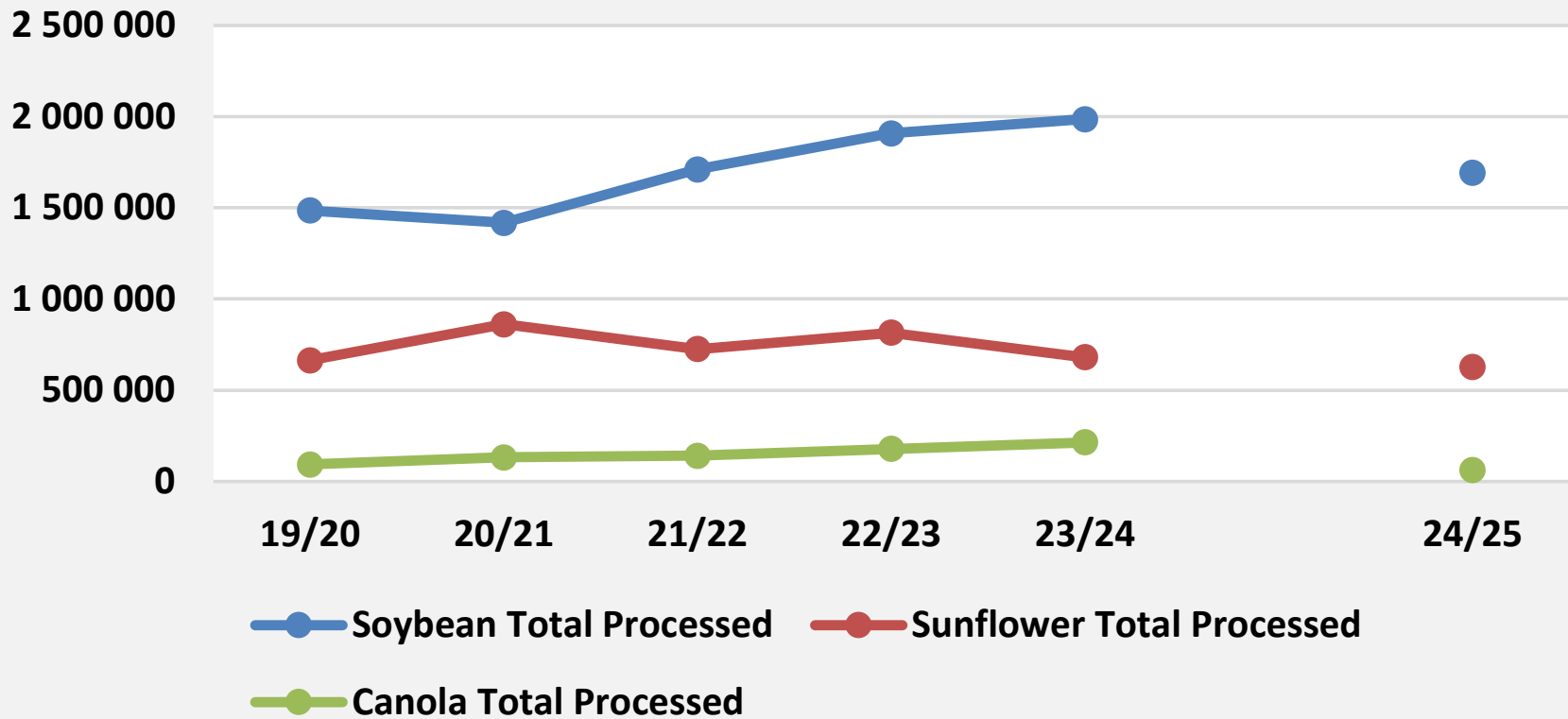

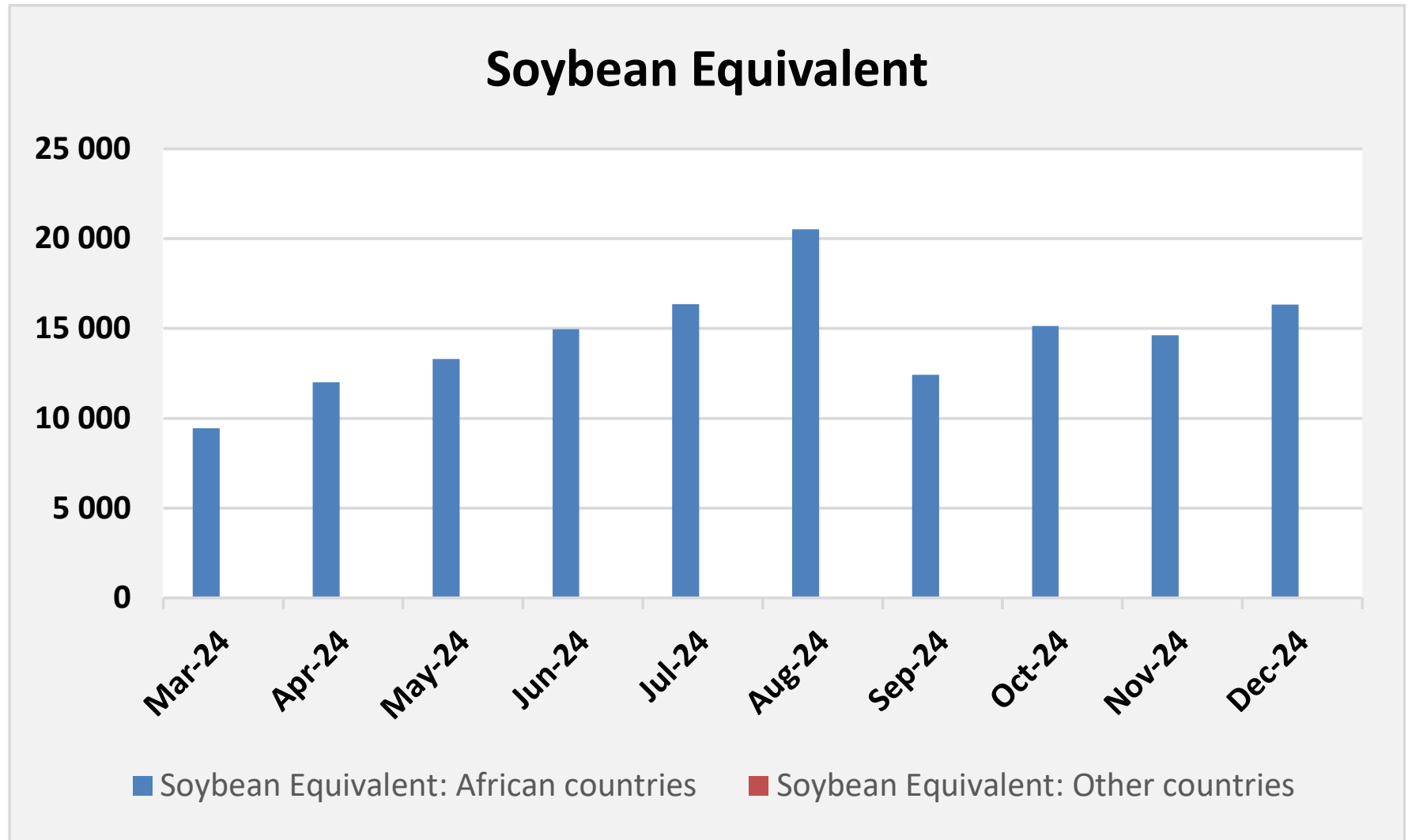

Whole Oilseeds: Total Processing (Incl. Product Exports)



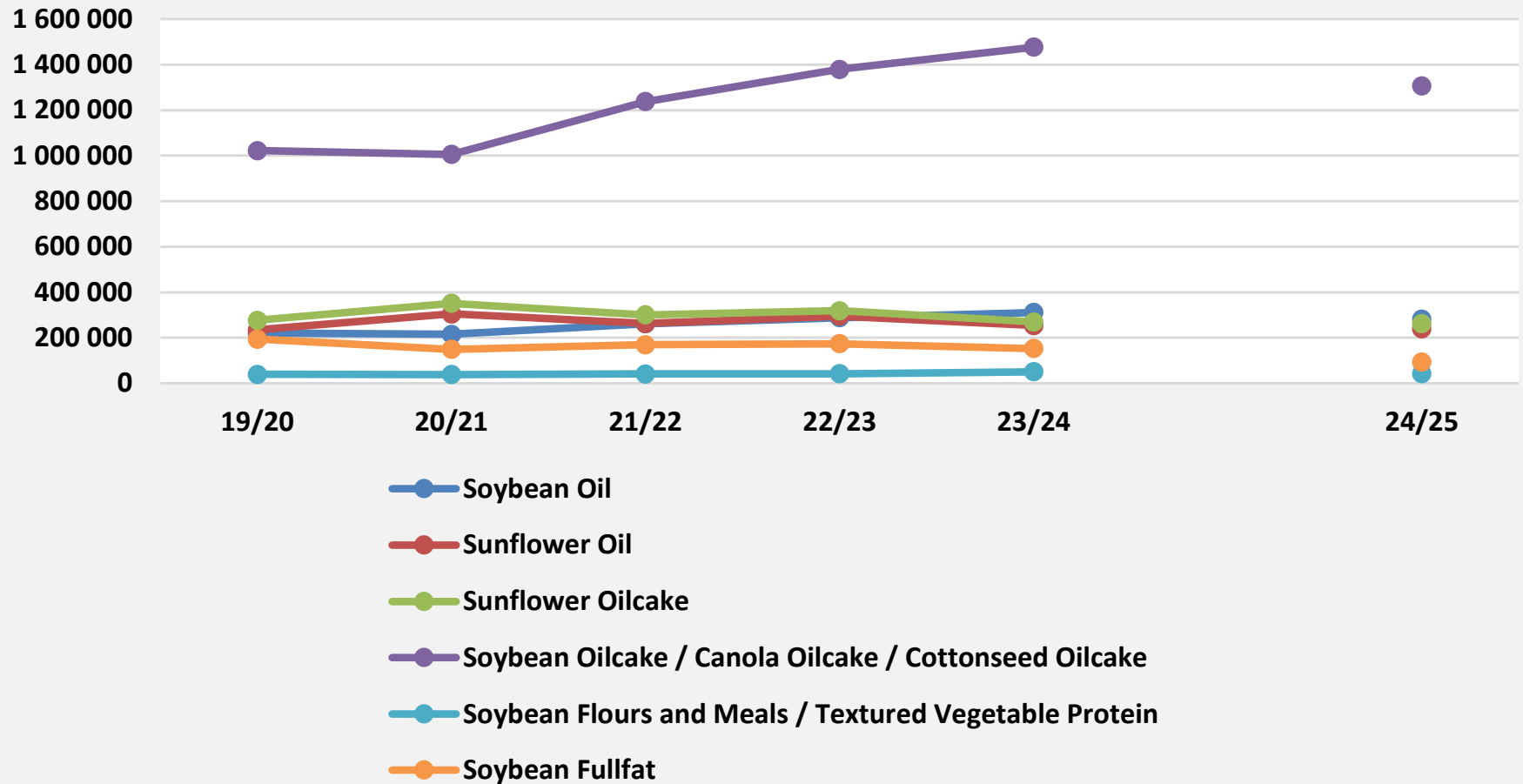
SAGIS Whole Soybean Equivalent of Products Exported



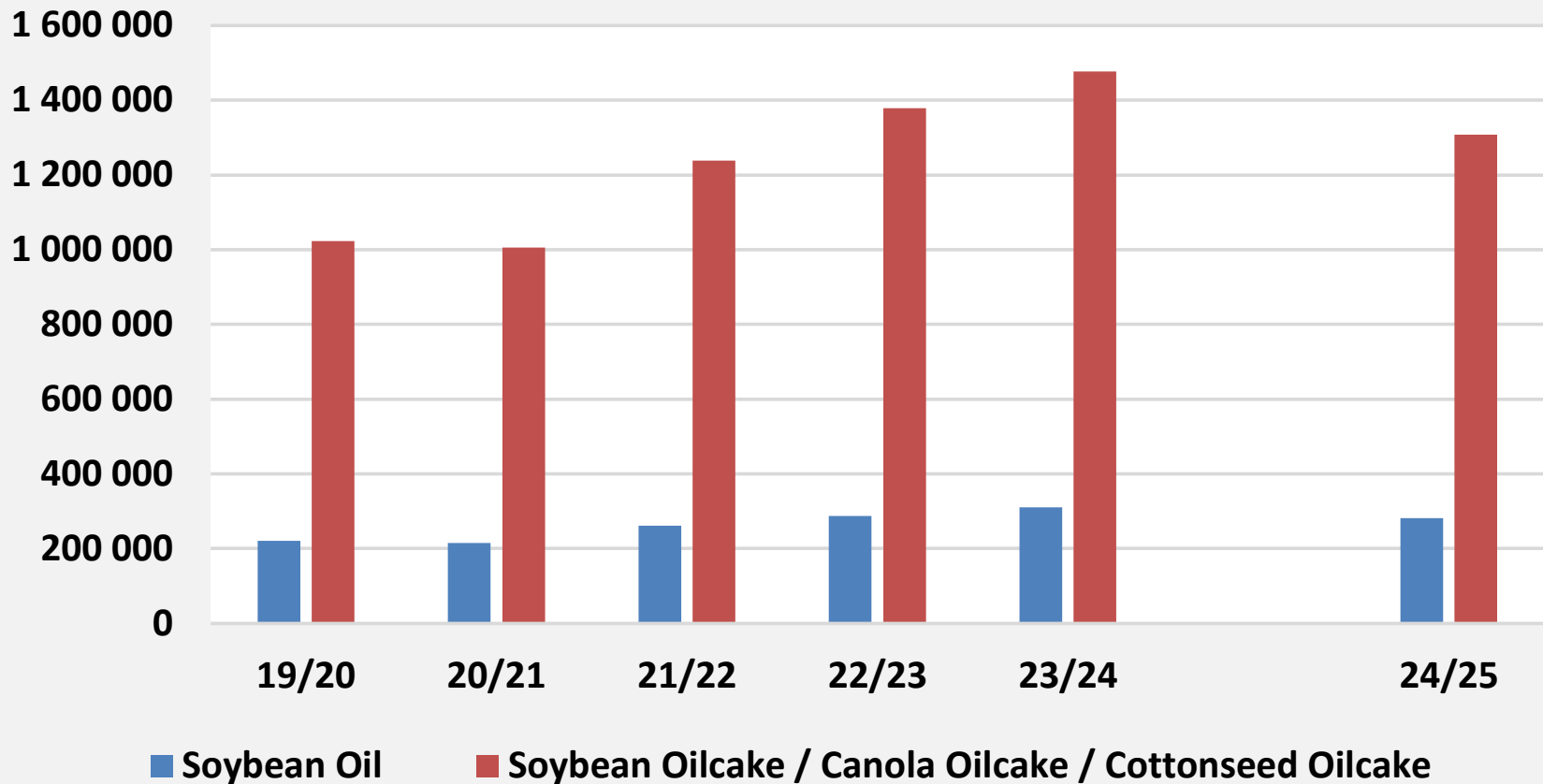
Oilseeds Products



Oilseed Product Manufactured

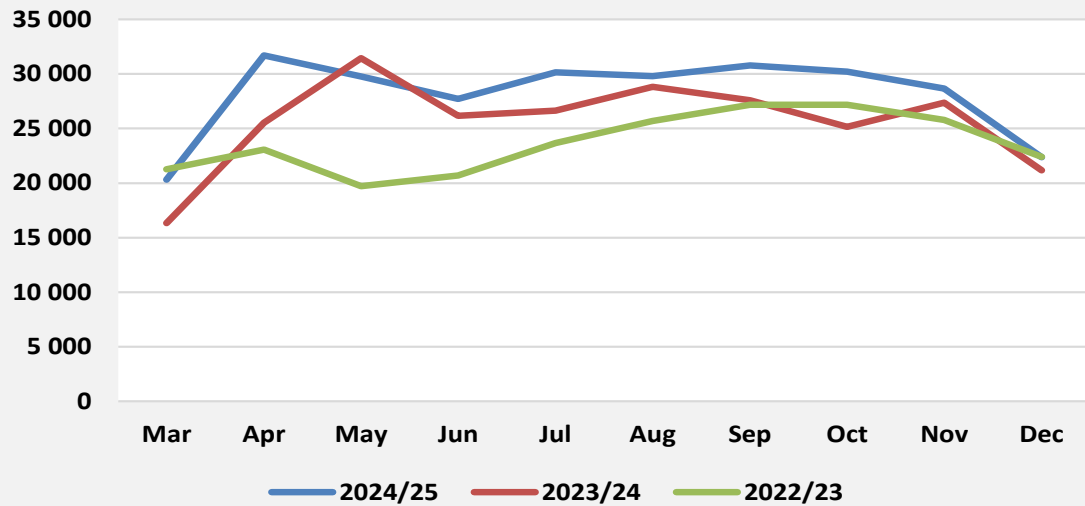


Products: Soybean Crushing

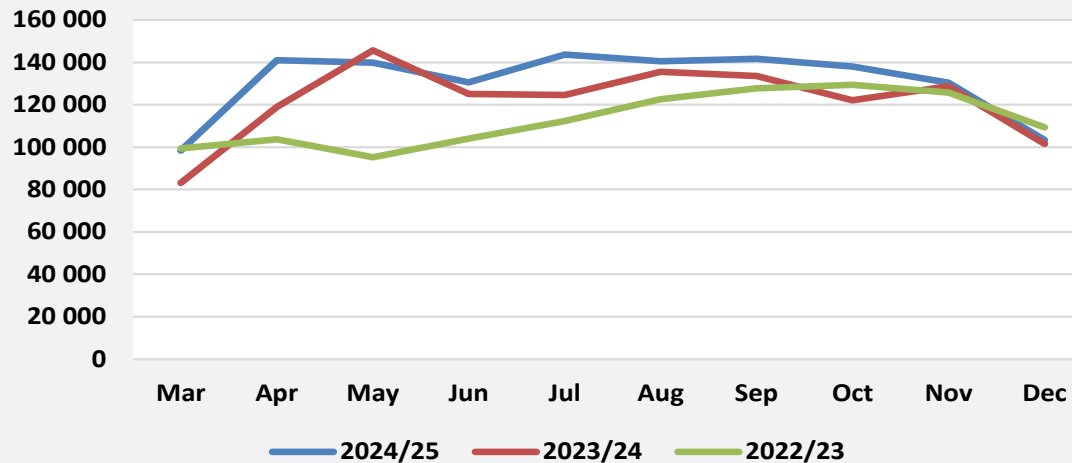

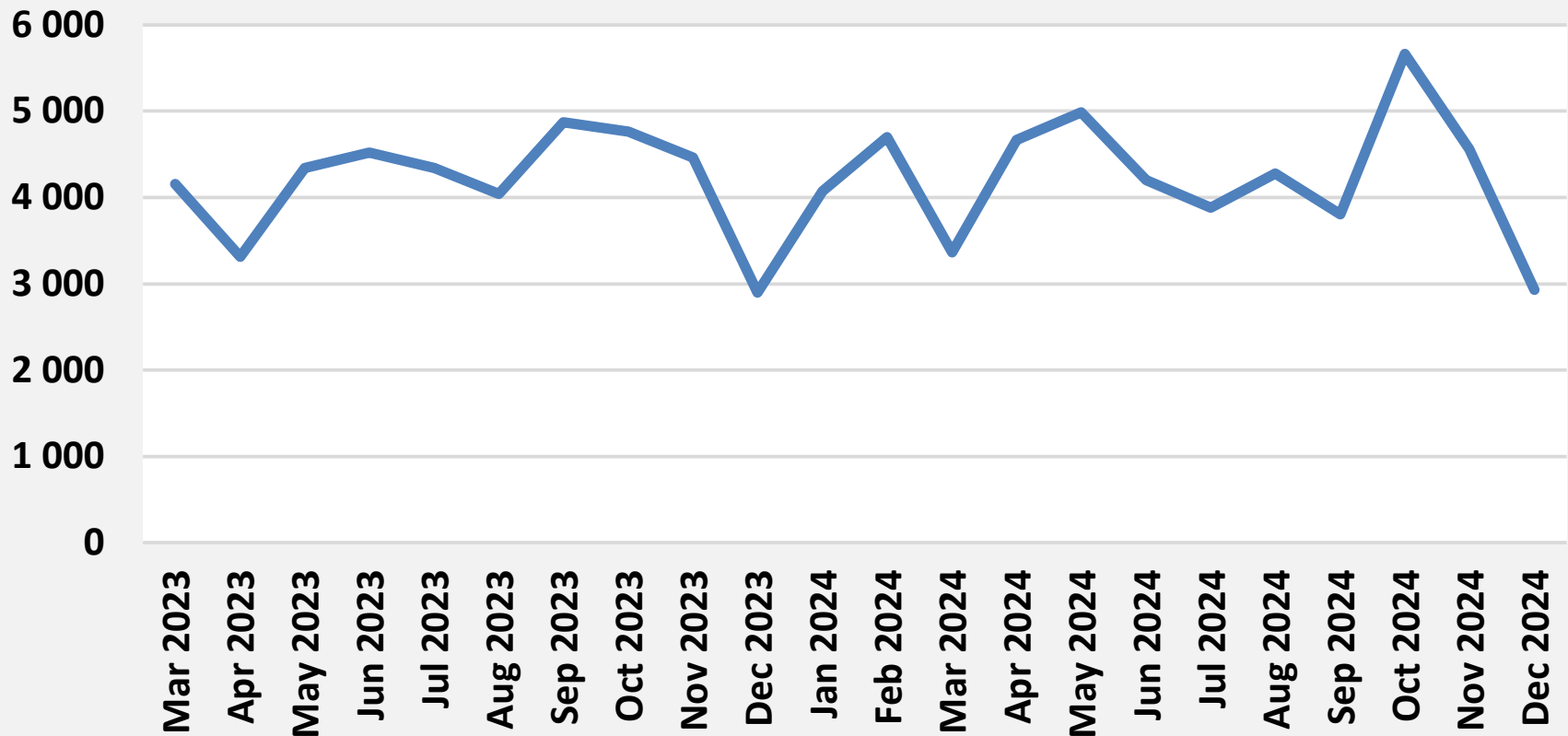
Products: Soybean Oil Manufactured



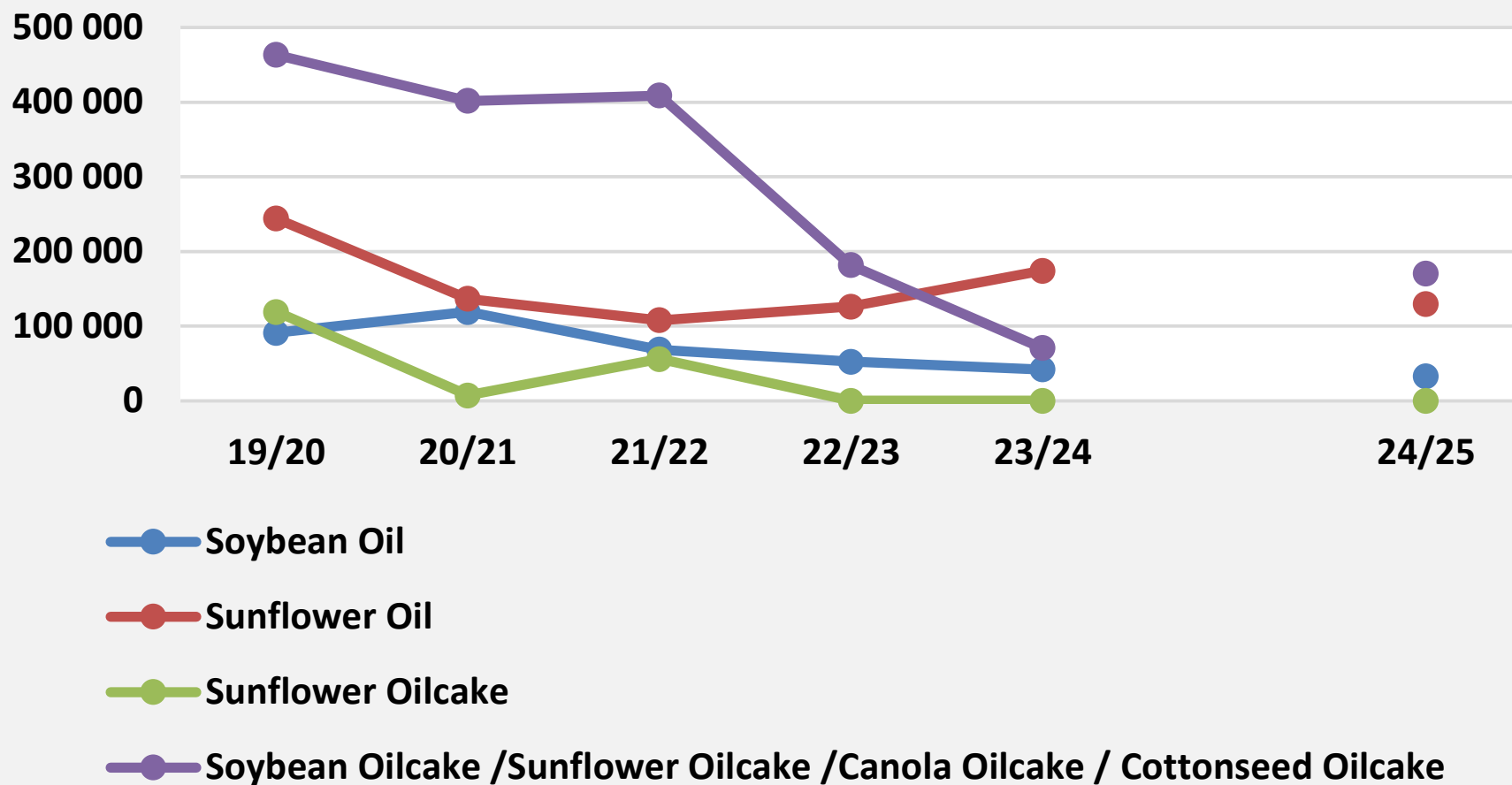
Soybean Oilcake / Canola Oilcake / Cottonseed Oilcake



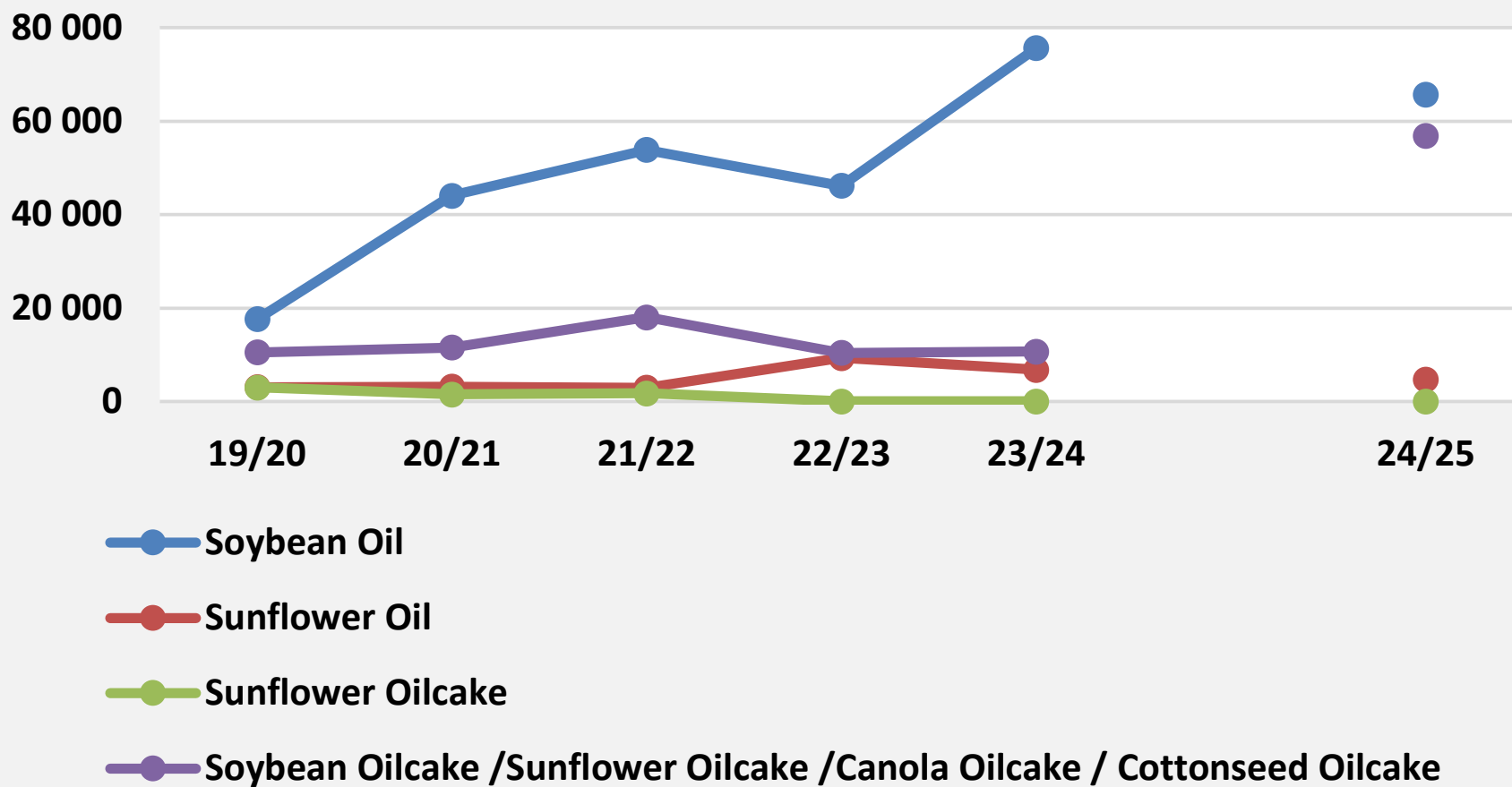
Soybean Flours and Meals / Textured Vegetable Protein



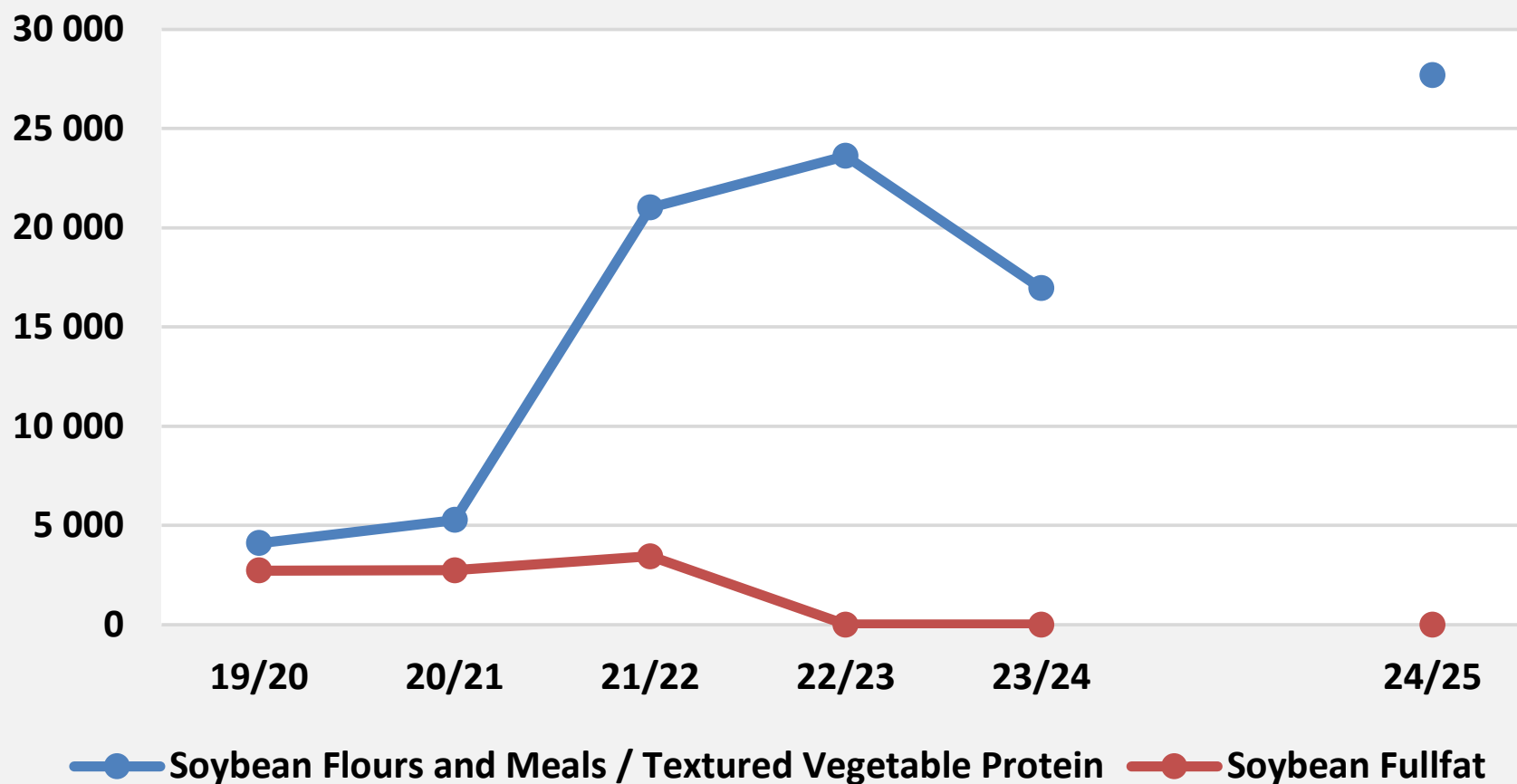
Products: Sunflower & Soybean Imports
